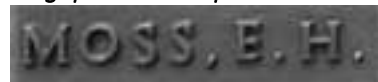

2. In accordance with Section 89 of the Courts Ordinance 1907 it is necessary for you to take and subscribe the Oath of Allegiance and the Judicial Oath before a Police Magistrate; I shall be pleased to administer the same in the Police Court any day during Office hours.

Informant states that on Sept: 25/15 at Halluch the above Officer, was leading his men in an attack which lasted for 3 days and on either the Saturday afternoon or Sunday morning they got into the 2nd or 3rd. German trench and Capt. Moss got hit by a hand grenade thrown by a German. Sergt Coomber was beside him and got killed too. This left the 12th Platoon with no Officer.
