I received a wire this morning from War Office informing me that my Brother 2 Lieut. J. Taylor 233rd Field Coy. R.E. has been dangerously wounded on May 11th & that I had to inform your office of next of kin. I am his Brother & live at above address. He has a wife who lives at Dalton Borton Westmorland & would be pleased if you would forward at your earliest any further news you may receive. I would esteem it a great favour if you would grant us two passes to travel & see him as his wife is not in a fit state to travel alone. Further you may see your way to grant us this request as he was from the Rank & we are not in a position to pay heavy travelling expenses.
